F.R.S.-FNRS participates in the following topics of the 9th JFS Call for Research Proposals:

General area: Climate Change Adaptation & Local Resilience

Topics:

- Waste water treatment and reuse (industrial & municipal)
- Underwater and above-water biomass farms working with renewable energy
- Assessment and remediation of contaminated inorganic and organic soils

Eligibility and funding modalities

All eligibility rules and criteria can be found in the **PINT-MULTI regulations**.

The maximum amount of requested funding per project is 100.000 EUR for a total period of three years.

Eligible cost categories

- Running costs (travel expenses, workshops and consumables etc.) and (small) Equipment are eligible for this call. Please consult of the PINT-MULTI regulations for further details.

- Personnel Costs

The maximum amount of funding does not allow to fund a PhD student for 4 years – therefore alternative funding for PhD completion should be considered.

- For "overhead" costs

Operating expenses: up to 1% within the granted budget. This percentage should be included in the requested operating budget.

Personnel: up to 2% outside of the granted budget. This percentage will be paid upon reimbursement of expenses to institutions by the F.R.S.-FNRS.

Submission in addition to PT Outline submission

Applicants to F.R.S.-FNRS funding must provide **compulsory additional submission via** e-space within 5 working days after the general deadline of JFS STI to be eligible. Please select the "PINT-MULTI" funding instrument when creating the administrative application.

Each proponent that requests funding from a JFS funder must carefully read the respective National Regulations and contact the National Focal Point for an informal eligibility pre-check before submission.

Before submission, it is advisable that each partner also reads the National Regulations of the other partners in the consortium, to understand and fit-in to the criteria specified in the partners' National Regulations.
