TÜBİTAK participates in the following topics of the 9th JFS Call for Research Proposals:

General area: Climate Change Adaptation & Local Resilience

Topics:

- Waste water treatment and reuse (industrial & municipal)
- Underwater and above-water biomass farms working with renewable energy
- Assessment and remediation of contaminated inorganic and organic soils

Eligibility and funding modalities

Universities, public institutions or organizations, research institutions, training and research hospitals and Turkish industry/private sector are allowed to apply to the call.

Turkish applicants will be funded under the TÜBİTAK 1071 Program in line with the regulations for enhancing participation in international R&D collaborations.

The maximum funding per project for Turkish applicants is €100,000, with the following distinctions:

- Universities, Public Institutions or Organizations, Research Institutions, Training and Research Hospitals: 100% of eligible costs
- Large Companies: Up to 60% of eligible costs
- SMEs: Up to 75% of eligible costs

Eligible cost categories

The following cost categories are considered eligible for fundinh:

- 1. Personnel Costs
- 2. Travel and Subsistence Costs
- 3. Equipment and Material Costs
- 4. Consultancy and Service Costs
- 5. Indirect Costs and Overheads
- 6. Other Costs

Applicants must ensure that all cost categories are in compliance with TÜBİTAK's national funding rules. Detailed budget justifications must be provided for each cost category. The conversion of costs in Turkish Lira to Euro should be based on the exchange rate set by the Central Bank of Türkiye at the time of application submission.

Submission in addition to PT Outline submission

In addition to the submission of the proposal through the dedicated online tool (PT-OUTLINE), Turkish applicants must complete their pre-application and full-application to the national programme via <u>https://uidb-pbs.tubitak.gov.tr</u>. All pre-applications should be signed with e-signatures.

Online national pre-application for the Call should be completed by 27 January 2025 (23:59, IST). Deadline for e-signature is 31 January 2025 (23:59, IST).

For the projects selected to be funded after the international evaluation process, Turkish Teams must have full-application. The deadline for the full-application will be announced by TÜBİTAK.
