Viet Nam participates in the following topics of the 9th JFS Call for Research Proposals:

General area: Climate Change Adaptation & Local Resilience

Topics:

- Waste water treatment and reuse (industrial & municipal)
- Underwater and above-water biomass farms working with renewable energy
- Assessment and remediation of contaminated inorganic and organic soils

Vietnamese applicants are advised to check with the respective national Contact Point the eligibility as to whom may apply and what costs are eligible before a consortium submits the complete application. Furthermore, it is recommended to Vietnamese applicants to read the Vietnamese call text in the website www.most.gov.vn, where Call text is published

Eligibility and funding modalities

Reasearch proposal may be submitted by:

- Resesearch institutions
- Unisversities
- SMEs

Located in the teritory of the Social Republic of Viet Nam.

Max. funding per project for three years: 300,000 €

The project proposal shall be evaluated based on the existing review mechanism of MOST. Accepted and approval proposal will receive funding under MOST joint research project scheme.

Eligible cost categories

For researchers funded by MOST, the funding is limited to :

Mobility of Vietnamese scientists and experts:

For Vietnamese scientists to country of research partner:

- Flights to and from destination: economy class flight
- Visa costs
- Transfer to and from the airport
- Daily allowance
- Insurance fees
- Instrument and material costs
- Small equipment can be covered if its project related need is clearly demonstrated
- Consumables can be covered if their project related need is clearly demonstrated
- Scientific events and projects meetings in Viet Nam
- Indirect cost used to cover the overhead expenses by the implementing institution in managing and monitoring the project. The administrative and project management cost shall fall under this account

For foreign scientists and experts:

All partner countries cover the costs for their participants based on their respective national regulations.
